Exposure Update – The cases reported last week have been cleared and have returned to work. There are no further cases to report at this time.

Employees Returning – Employees shall be returning in phases over the next few months. June 22nd should initiate the first wave of returnees. The Company shall advise the Union when subsequent waves of employees are scheduled to return.

Gown Production – Gown Production. pictures of our members hard at work can be seen on the next page. We are proud of the work our members are doing in this effort.

Misting – A complete round of misting has been completed, a new schedule for another round will be submitted to the your Committee soon.

Hand Sanitizers – 3 oz. bottles of hand sanitizers will be distributed around the facilities common areas (i.e. conference rooms/breakrooms), once they are gone, that will be the end of the supply. Use sparingly.

Masks – the Committee has learned that masks are not being worn in the workplace. The Company has clearly stated that the wearing of Masks wearing in the workplace is **MANDATORY**. Temporary removal of masks is allowed during breaks and lunches away from other employees, or if you need to breathe - go outside away from others, remove your mask catch your breath, resume wearing the mask and return to work. We will only stay safe if we use common sense by following CDC guidelines. If employees you work around are not wearing masks while working; please call them on it and contact your committee members if they persist. **remember, all employees, LM Space or Contractors, have to wear masks on Company grounds.**

IAM Masks – The Union Hall is closed to foot traffic due to the corona virus; your stewards are providing me with a list of employees within the departments. We will get these masks to your stewards soon. When you receive them, be safe and wash & dry before using. The Union has received an additional shipment of masks this afternoon and will provide members with **one additional mask for a total of two per member;** we will keep you informed.

Symptom Checking Prior to Work –LM Space employees as well as vendors, are to self-check their symptoms prior to coming into the facility. Temperature checking stations are located at all Bay Area locations; B/202 in Palo Alto, B/602 in Santa Cruz, and the Visitors Center in Sunnyvale. **If a temperature of 100.4 is indicated you are to go home and contact the hot line.**
